Are you a loving person? What kind of people do you love? Do you love people that have hurt you, ruined your trust, and taken advantage of your kindness or generosity? Do you love those that do not have the same political views? Do you love those that don't have the same worship style?

John 17:23 "so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me."

This verse has stuck with me this week after preaching on John 17. It has made the parable of the unmerciful servant in Matthew 18:23-35 come alive to me. Now I know, like any one of our kids in Sunday School, that God loves us but this verse goes so much deeper than my mind can fathom. God loves those that have become his child the same way that he loves Christ. If you turn back to John 13, you find Christ teaching that all men will know we are his disciples by the way we love one another. How do we know how to love one another? We know this love because we have experienced this love. Therefore, when we don't love in this manner it demonstrates we must remind ourselves of the love that we have experience from God. We were rebels against God. (Rom 5:8) We were dead in our sins, lived in the passion of our flesh, and followed after Satan. (Eph 2:1-3) And yet, God in the midst of this has forgiven those who have repented of their sins and believed in Jesus Christ. Not only forgiven, but loved us with the same love that he has for his only begotten Son. I pray that this fact would overwhelm us. It is imperative that we never lose sight of the greatness of God's love and would then love others with the same love. This kind of love would change our church and our community because it would reflect and point people to God. Love one another and be unified in our mission for Christ that the world may know the one true God.

MAWLING

FOR STRONG DISCIPLES WHO MAKE STRONG DISCIPLES

Have you ever had to train someone to do what you do at your job, at home, at school, etc.? When you have to do this, it causes you to think about what you do in a whole different way. Let's take driving as an example. I drive to work every day but I never really think about how I do it. My wife would agree :) However, I have to put on my seatbelt, depress the brake, put the key in the ignition, start the car, look in my mirrors, check the road, put it in reverse, etc. Even though I don't think about the process, when training someone else to do it, I have to explain each and everything.

MODEL it, **ASSIST** them in doing it, **WATCH** them do it and then **LEAVE** them to do it on their own.

This is a process and must be done in a particular order or things will not happen correctly. If we do not MAWL trainees, there could even be injuries!

Training disciples is no different. We must be very particular in how, when, what, and why we train them so they can grow to be mature leaders and reproduce this training with other disciples in their lives. We see this type of training clearly in Luke chapters 8-10.

Luke 8:1-3: *Soon afterward he went on through the cities and villages, proclaiming and bringing the good news of the kingdom of God. **AND THE TWELVE WERE WITH HIM...***

In this passage, we see Jesus **MODELING** several things to the twelve as well as some other folks. He was modeling, going, evangelizing, discipling and training leaders.

Luke 9:1-6: *And he called the **TWELVE** together and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God..."take nothing for your journey"... whatever house you enter, stay there...and they departed and went through the villages...*

In this passage, we see Jesus **ASSISTING** and **WATCHING** the twelve as he gives them power and authority. He then sends them out with specific instructions to rely on God to provide for their physical needs as well as believers to disciple.

Luke 10:1-12: *After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them ahead of him...where he himself was about to go...*

In this passage, we see Jesus taking a larger group of followers and sending them in the same way that he originally sent the twelve. Thus, we see his heart for reproducing disciples. He was going to go behind them to check that what they were doing was being correctly reproduced according to his modeling, assisting and watching. Because he trained them in this way, when he **LEFT** they were able to continue in the work!

Can Jesus have that same confidence in us? Are you one who disciples disciples to make disciples? Are you modeling what Jesus taught and did? Are you spending time with them so that you can assist and watch them as they try to do what you've modeled? Are you leaving them, so they can try it on their own and then debriefing with them? Most of the time MAWL, whether in the example of training a person to drive or in discipleship, will look more like MMMAAAWWMMMAWLLM etc. The Christian life is messy because we are all sinners saved by grace. Be ready to get your hands dirty!
